Allan Neville DONALDSON, RHB RM (Born 4 June 1919 at Corinda). He was awarded Life Membership of the club on 27 July 1967. He was club patron for the season of 1979-80.

Neville Donaldson scored 2920 runs in a career interrupted by the war. Neville was noted for two things - his brilliant outfielding and his forceful batting and big hitting. Neville won the Telegraph Trophy for fastest century during the 1939-40 season. Playing against Colts he scored a century in 70 minutes and finished with 172 runs scored in 94 minutes. I doubt if this fast scoring rate has been exceeded. In one of the 8 ball overs he hit 5 sixes. He later scored another century in 34 minutes. On retirement Neville devoted many years in coaching the club's junior players with outstanding success.
