

MATCH COMMITTEE:

Overall description -

Deal with any matters that may arise concerning misconduct by a persons or persons whilst representing the WSDCC as a player or official

Match Committee Composition:

- - Secretary/Administrator
- - Director of Cricket
- - Club Coach
- - President
- - Player's Representative

Match Committee Powers:

General

- A matter(s) of alleged misconduct is to be reported to the Cricket Manager who will, subject to the nature of the report, determine whether or not the matter warrants convening the match committee
- If an inquiry is warranted, to summon any person or persons to appear before the match committee in relation to the report of alleged misconduct
- To inquire of the reported person or persons if they are willing to be dealt with by the match committee should they be found to have brought the Club into disrepute by their alleged misconduct, and
- If the person is willing to be dealt with by the match committee, to impose any sanction deemed appropriate for the misconduct, or
- If the person is not willing to be dealt with by the match committee, then refer the matter to the Executive Committee of the Club for determination

Specific Authority:

- Upon notification of any matter that, in the opinion of the Secretary/ Administrator, may have an adverse effect upon the reputation of the Club, the Cricket Administrator is empowered to convene a meeting of the Match Committee.
- In so determining to convene a meeting, the Secretary/Administrator is to notify the person or persons against whom it is alleged that through their words or conduct that they have brought the Clubs reputation into disrepute to attend at a meeting of the Match Committee.
- The Match Committee is likewise empowered to require the attendance of any person who in the opinion of the Secretary/Administrator may materially assist the committee in its investigations into the matters referred to the committee.
- Upon the convening of such a meeting, the Match Committee shall require the person or persons notified to appear before the committee and against whom it is alleged that through their words or conduct that they brought the Clubs reputation into disrepute, to answer the allegation.
- If a person who, having been notified to appear before the Match Committee, fails to appear at the time and date specified, the Match Committee may proceed to deal with the matter referred to it in the person's absence.



- Upon hearing submissions from persons summonsed before it, the Match Committee may then determine to require a person or persons to show cause why the match Committee should not impose a penalty against the person or persons for having brought the Clubs reputation into disrepute.
- Should the Match Committee determine to, and impose a penalty, the person or persons upon whom the penalty is imposed upon is to be informed that they may appeal the Match Committees decision and that such appeal shall be dealt with by the Club at a time and date to be specified.
- The minutes of any meeting convened by the Match Committee are to be presented to and tabled at the next Executive Committee meeting of the Club.
